ORDER

With a view to effectively implement the functions and duties enshrined upon the Commission and with a view to ensure compliance of all directions issued by the Commission, till date, the Commission in exercise of the statutory powers conferred upon it hereby direct that the following steps are taken in view of the compelling need to prevent any further deterioration of environment and towards improvement of air quality in Delhi and NCR.

2. In exercise of the powers conferred under section 11(5) of the Commission for Air Quality Management in National Capital Region and Adjoining Areas Act, 2021 and in exercise of all enabling provisions made thereunder and in view of the emergent need, the Commission constituted the below mentioned Special Force called "Enforcement Task Force" to monitor and supervise the implementation of the statutory directions issued till date. The "Enforcement Task Force" shall consist of the following persons-

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3. The said "Enforcement Task Force" shall inspect and continuously supervise and monitor the compliance of the directions issued by the commission through "inspection teams / flying squads" constituted as per **Annexure** to this order.

4. The said flying squads would continuously make surprise visits, periodical incognito checking and inspections and will report to the Enforcement Task Force daily. The Enforcement Task Force would meet every day at 6 PM either physically or through virtual mode to take stock of the situation.

5. Any non-compliance of the directions issued by the Commission as reported to Enforcement Task Force by the flying squad shall be taken seriously and the Enforcement Task Force would pass such preventive, closure or seizure order(s), in exercise of the powers conferred upon it under the Act, which would be over and above such other preventive, corrective and punitive actions like financial penalty and criminal prosecution as prescribed by the law.

6. The respective implementing agencies viz. the State Government authorities, the Central Pollution Control Board and State pollution Control Boards will also continue to ensure compliance and strict implementation of the directives issued by the Commission and submit their daily action taken report the same to the Enforcement Task Force on daily basis.

7. Any dereliction in duty by any of the Members of the flying squad or the implementing agency will also attract disciplinary proceedings as may be considered appropriate by the Commission in accordance with the law.

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8. There are 124 number of border entry points to NCT of Delhi. The concerned State Government will ensure deployment of teams from the Road Transport Department of the concerned States along with requisite number of police personnel at every border entry point for 24 hours, in rotation. These teams shall be responsible to ensure that directions contained in S. No. (V) of the Direction No. 46 dated 02.12.2021 are scrupulously complied with. The police officials of each of the State Governments shall render necessary help by deploying as much personnel as is requisitioned by the Enforcement Task Force.
