ORDER

Sub: Action against grossly violating C&D sites, imposition and realisation of appropriate environment compensation charges and closures- reg.

Various emission inventory studies and source apportionment models point to significantly high contribution / influence of dust from various construction / demolition activities in infrastructure / housing / other works, to the overall adverse air quality scenario prevailing in Delhi and other areas in NCR round the year and particularly in the summer season.

2. To this effect, besides directing for effective implementation the C&D Waste Management Rules, 2016 notified by the MoEFCC and "Guidelines on dust mitigation measures in handling construction material and C&D wastes, 2017" issued by the CPCB, the Commission issued **Statutory Directions Nos.** 11-18 dated 11.06.2021 for Remote monitoring of dust control measures at construction and demolition sites in NCR through a web-portal and **Direction** No. 69 dated 02.11.2022 for Deployment of adequate numbers of anti-smog guns in proportion to the area under construction for all C&D projects in NCR. **Direction No. 79 dated 13.02.2024** was further issued to all agencies issuing completion certificates / occupancy certificates for C&D projects to issue such certificates only after ensuring that no closure direction is pending against the project. An Advisory No. 12 dated 14.02.2024 has also been issued to ULBs and project monitoring agencies to incorporate measures towards abatement of dust in the respective permissions / sanctions, including in the conditions of contracts / agreements.

- 3. The Hon'ble Supreme Court, while hearing the matter under WP (C) 13029/1985 M.C. Mehta Vs UOI & Ors. vide its order dated 22.04.2024 have expressed their concern on the non-compliances of various statutes and guidelines in this regard and have inter alia directed as under:
 - 13 (a) Some authority must verify whether all construction sites involved in construction and demolition (C&D) activities have been registered on respective web portals
 - 13 (b) There are number of non-compliant C&D activities site. However, action of closure appears to have been initiated only against selected few. Dust pollution is created by C&D activities and therefore, stricter action is required against the non-compliant C&D sites
- 4. Towards compliance of the Hon'ble Supreme Court's orders and directions, it is hereby reiterated and ordered that under no circumstances any project on a plot area of ≥ 500 sqm be permitted to take up construction/demolition activities until and unless it is registered on the web-portal of the concerned NCR state PCB / DPCC and also fulfils the other requisites as per the statutory directions. Any project violating the above statutory directions needs to be immediately issued a "closure" direction.
- 5. It further needs to be also ensured that for smaller C&D projects, which are not mandated to be registered on the web portal, all prescribed measures towards dust suppression and mitigation are scrupulously implemented and followed by all the project proponents and project implementing / monitoring agencies. Concerted inspection drives need to be therefore, carried out and deterrent punitive actions need to be taken against grossly violating C&D sites including imposition and realisation of appropriate environment compensation charges and closures, if warranted.
- 6. Status in the above context may be submitted to the Commission as a part of the monthly report on abatement of air pollution from the C&D sector, being submitted to the Commission hitherto.
